Report of Russia economy representative Mr. T.Iakubov "Enhancing Russia-Asia Supply Chain Connectivity by Dry Port Network Implementation"

Current container turnover Asia – Europe bound is about 7 mln TEU, Europe – Asia about 3 mln TEU. These supply chains are served mainly through linear maritime services from the major APEC sea ports, while such service is characterized with fixed schedule and predictable prices.

Enhancement of Russia's national transport system and transit potential envisages, inter alia, implementation of concept of Rail Dry Ports, related to the national rail network. RDP network plans are stipulated by the UN ESCATO Intergovernmental Agreement on Dry Ports.

RDP network shall be set up as a single logistic network, implementing unified technical/technological and tariff policies. Regular cargo transport is to be organized similar to passenger transport (fixed schedule etc.), train loading/unloading fronts shall enable to avoid train breaking at the terminal. RDP network functioning shall allow increase of delivery speed and transport costs reduction, aiming at optimization of supply chains and distribution network.

Dry ports design envisages that the logistics terminals shall form an infrastructure basis for further development of industrial/logistics parks in the vicinity.

The pilot RDP projects are represented by Bely Rast TLC (Moscow region) and Doskino TLC (Nizhny Novgorod region).




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TLC «BELY RAST» Positioning




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HONG KONG, CHINA National Dry Ports Network (Rail)


